Dr. Hiral Tipirneni Announces “The System,” Third Ad Buy for AZ-08 General Election

*Highlights That Changing the Culture of Petty Politics and Deceit Starts
by Electing a Representative Who Puts People First*

PEORIA, AZ – Today Dr. Hiral Tipirneni, an emergency room physician, cancer research advocate, and candidate for Arizona’s 8th Congressional District (AZ-08), announced her campaign’s third ad of the 2018 general election. “I’ve been speaking with voters from across the political spectrum for more than a year now, and it’s abundantly clear they are tired of Washington’s overheated rhetoric and petty politics,” Dr. Tipirneni said. “They want to know there’s someone in DC with integrity who’s honestly fighting for them, not using a rigged system to cater to their corporate donors and party overlords,” Hiral stated.

Recently, career politician and incumbent Rep. Debbie Lesko [lost the endorsement of the Arizona Medical Association](#) – a first in its 125-year history - for her ongoing use of defamatory signs regarding Dr. Tipirneni’s medical degree and valid license, as well as deceptive TV and digital ads attempting to gain political ground by [ignoring the deaths](#) of Dr. Tipirneni’s mother and young nephew. [The American Healthcare Coalition also called](#) for the endorsement to be rescinded.

Debbie’s antics have led her to be described as “[desperate](#)” and “[flat-out lying](#),” “[a fake](#),” “[a sleaze](#),” and having “[Not. A. Clue](#)” regarding solutions to problems facing AZ-08 residents.

“If we keep electing the same types of people, we can’t expect different outcomes from our representatives. But in November, we can start changing the Washington culture of deceit by electing people who put voters first,” Dr. Tipirneni added.

Tipirneni is closing on Lesko 48-44, according to a [recent survey](#) of AZ-08 voters. This poll showed that since an August 2018 baseline survey, **Tipirneni has closed a 9-point deficit, putting her within the margin of error**, and poised to flip this congressional seat.
